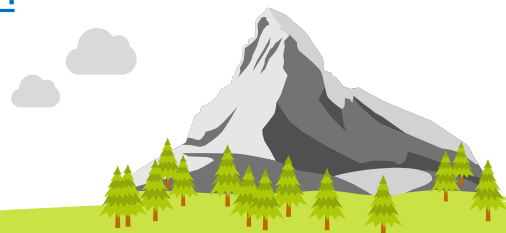

Azure Communication Services is GA in Switzerland North

- Local data residency not reflected on Azure.com products-per-region page since this is a so-called non-regional service
- Switzerland North selectable in the Azure portal as deployment region
- Switzerland will be added to this page later

- On a global basis – not just Swiss DC – this service currently has a limitation with US numbers only

- Status update
- Target date per current planning
- Managed access launch for foundational services.
- After the managed access launch, mainstream services will deploy over the course of several months.
 - The public page talks about 90 days – this cannot be guaranteed for all services.
 - These services rollouts will be prioritized based on demand for the most important Swiss AZs customers.
- Start customer resiliency discussions sooner rather than later: there is work to do to take advantage of Availability Zones – do not wait for the launch to have such conversations.



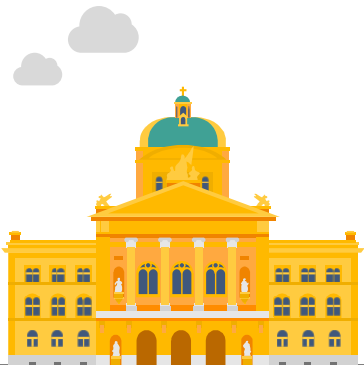
Azure Confidential Computing Heads-up



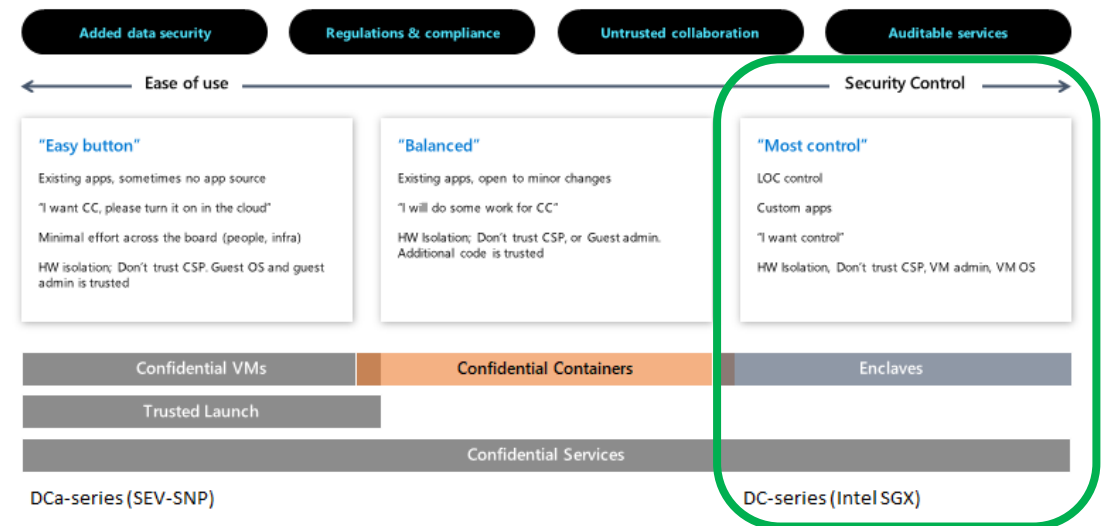
Information under NDA



- Per current planning, Azure Confidential Computing in the SGX Intel variation will come with DCsv3 VMs to one zone in Switzerland North in the next quarter as a target date
- Will receive just the secure VMs – so far not received a signal that customers also need confidential computing for e.g. SQL, AKS or App Service.
- Huge investment to Swiss region, ahead of e.g. GER or FR

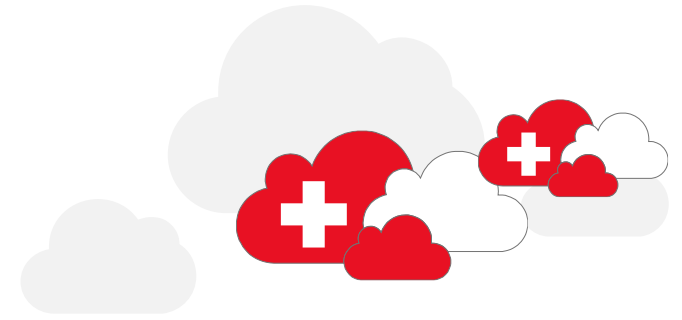

D365 F&SCM/O Microservices



- Most Microservices only available as global services, without local data residency
- Locally deployed: Export to Data Lake, Tax Calculation and Electronic Invoicing
- Could be deployed locally based on demand with Biz Case:
 - Connected Factory, Master Planning, Inventory, Cost Accounting, Cloud and Edge
